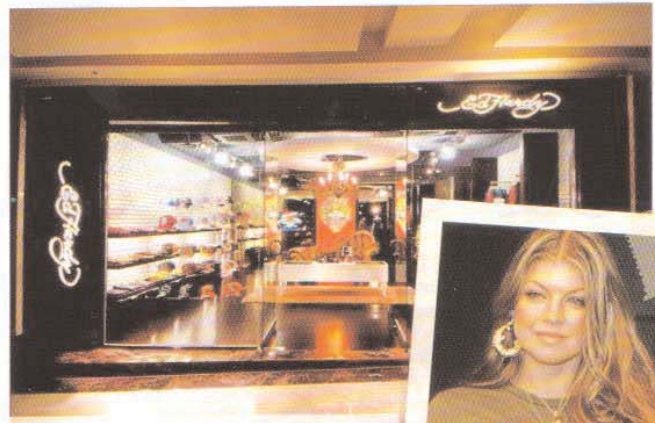
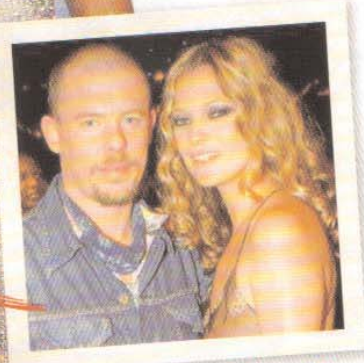


MOSS TO MARRY IN MCQUEEN?

ED HARDY LAUNCHES IN OZ

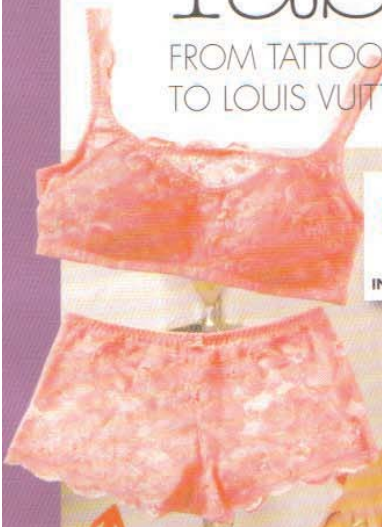
